# TEST RETAKE POLICY

While no students with a passing grade are required to retake a test, we see it as an opportunity for students to relearn the content and demonstrate proficiency.

In order to take full advantage of this retake opportunity, there are some steps students will be required to complete to prove they have practiced and are ready to test again.

Students will need to complete a test retake form completely, following all the steps, and get a parent/guardian signature to confirm the additional practice.

If the scheduled retake time conflicts with the student's schedule, recess may be used in order to complete a retake.

• Math

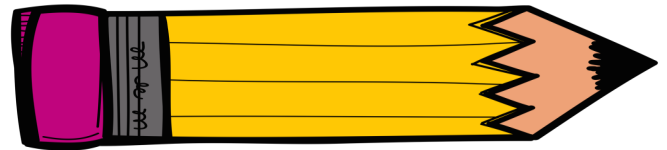
• Science
